Preface

The index is intended to be used in conjunction with the “List of Articles”, where more details about the article can generally be found. This combination should enable the user to pinpoint which articles to read. The index is sorted by country together with several 'general' categories (includes book and catalogue review lists).

The following format is used: “a/b/c” refers to volume “a”, issue number “b”, and page number “c”. In the volume number, the PL prefix refers to “Precancelist” (issued February 1947 to Jan-Feb 1954), LS refers to “Lee’s Summit” (issued from April 1954 to September 1954), and no prefix refers to “Precancels” (first issue dated October 1954).

Entries without a named topic are of general precancel information; named topics are indented entries. To reduce repetition, a second level of indentation is sometimes used. Many articles are included more than once; for example, bureau counterfeits is listed both under ‘bureau’ and ‘counterfeit’.
