Preface

Many articles have been published by the PSS-GB on a wide variety of precancel topics. To minimize the size (and the work involved!), the compilation presented here does not include items such as AGM reports, membership, library and auction lists, new towns issuing precancels, stamp counts, catalogue updates, new catalogue and book announcements (but reviews are included); In addition, the following are not included: meeting announcements, secretary's reports, most letters, some of the Magpie's Nest notes, members' wants & sales, advertisements, articles submitted by the British Commercial Overprint Study Circle (BCOSC), a sub-group of the PSS-GB founded in December 1988. This has resulted in a list of over 1300 entries for the 432 issues that have been published from 1947 to 2009 inclusive.

In an attempt to make the “List of Articles” more useful, I have added items or comments to the title in some cases; these are contained within a pair of square brackets, such as [short note], [illustrated], [see also v. no. p.] to reference a related article, and [part 1 of 3], for example, where an article has been split into separate issues.

The following format is used: “a/b” refers to volume “a” and issue number “b”. In the volume number, the PL prefix refers to “Precancelist” (issued from February 1947 to Jan-Feb 1954), LS refers to “Lee’s Summit” (issued from April 1954 to September 1954), and no prefix refers to “Precancels” (first issue dated October 1954). In the case of a few volumes, the pages are numbered sequentially throughout all the issues so that the issue number is not required, but it has been included for consistency.

In spite of checking the entries, I am sure that many errors remain but I hope that the majority of these are ‘minor’. There will also be examples of inconsistencies in the selection process of which articles to include, but hopefully, this will not be a major drawback.
